Make your own Memorial Day Wind Catcher!

You will need:

- 2 paper plates
- Scissors
- Red & blue markers
- 2 pieces of string



- Step 1: With your red marker, make 3 thick stripes on your plate.
- Step 2: On your other paper plate, cut out a large star and color it blue.
- Step 3: Make a 2 holes in your star one at the top point and one at the bottom.
- Step 4: Cut a spiral shape into your plate with the red stripes.
- Step 5: Make a hole at the top of your red spiral plate.
- Step 6: Put one piece of string and tie a knot through the top point of your star.
- Then put the second piece of string in the bottom hole of the star and the hole in your spiral plate and tie a knot.
- Step 7: Hang it outside for Memorial Day and watch it sway in the wind!
