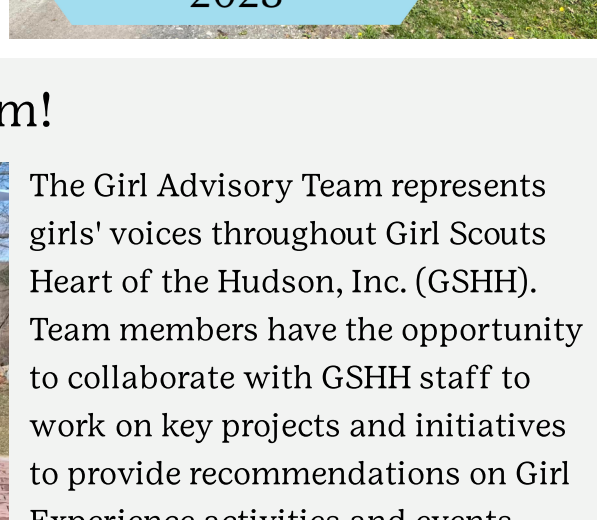

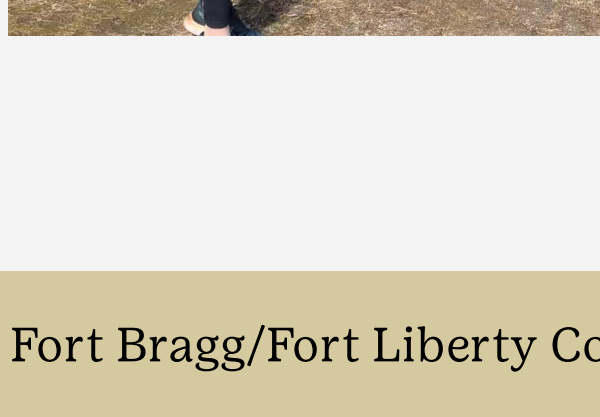

Join the Girl Advisory Team!



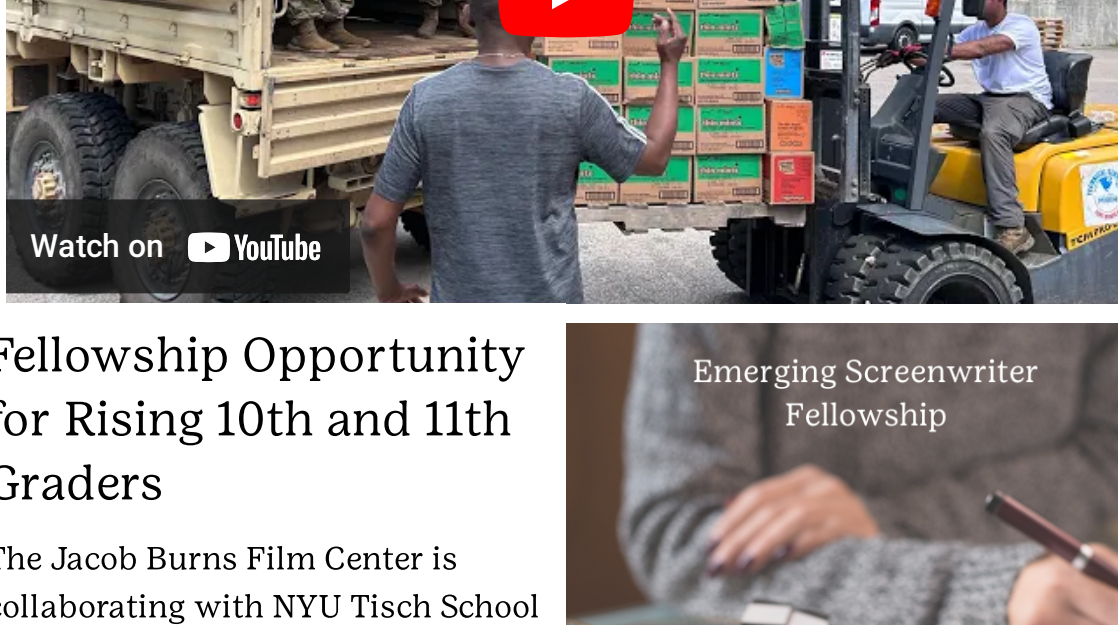

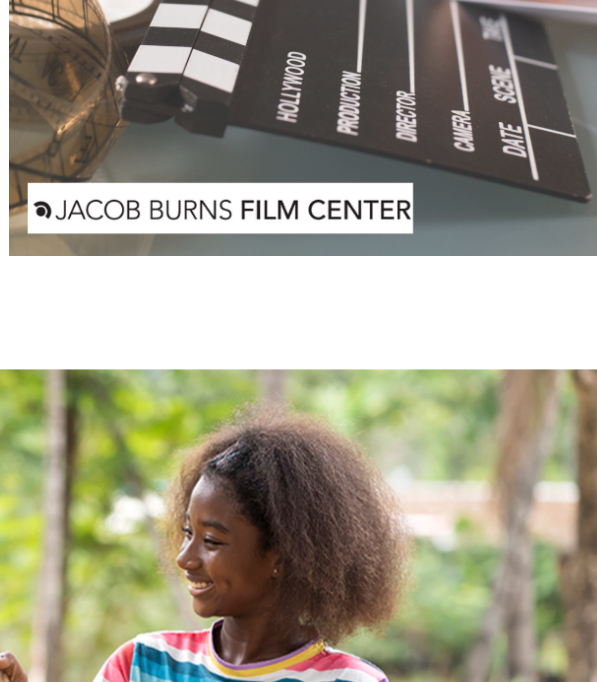
Fort Bragg/Fort Liberty Cookie Donations

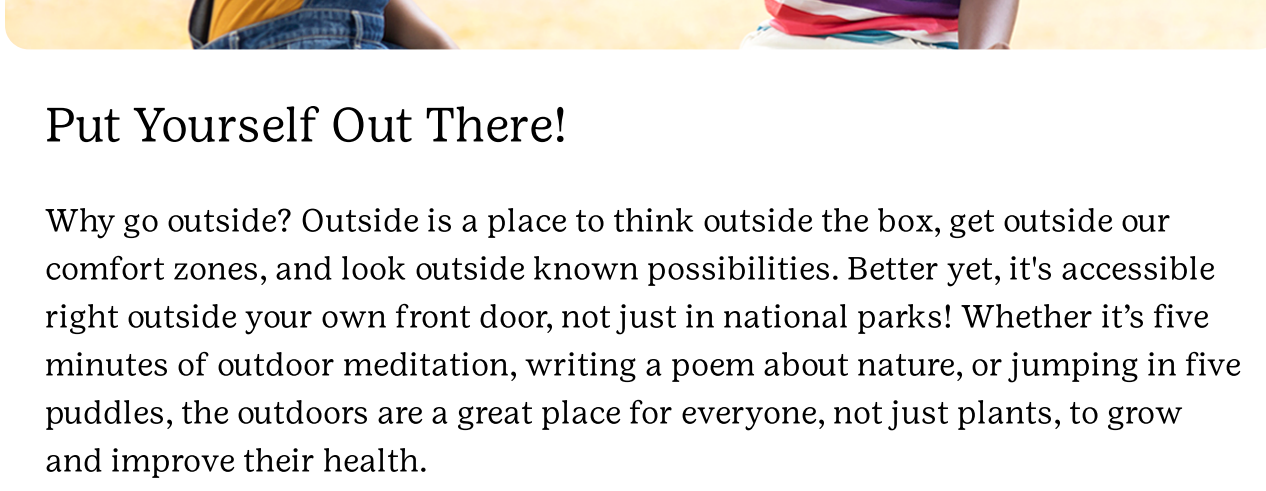


Fellowship Opportunity for Rising 10th and 11th Graders

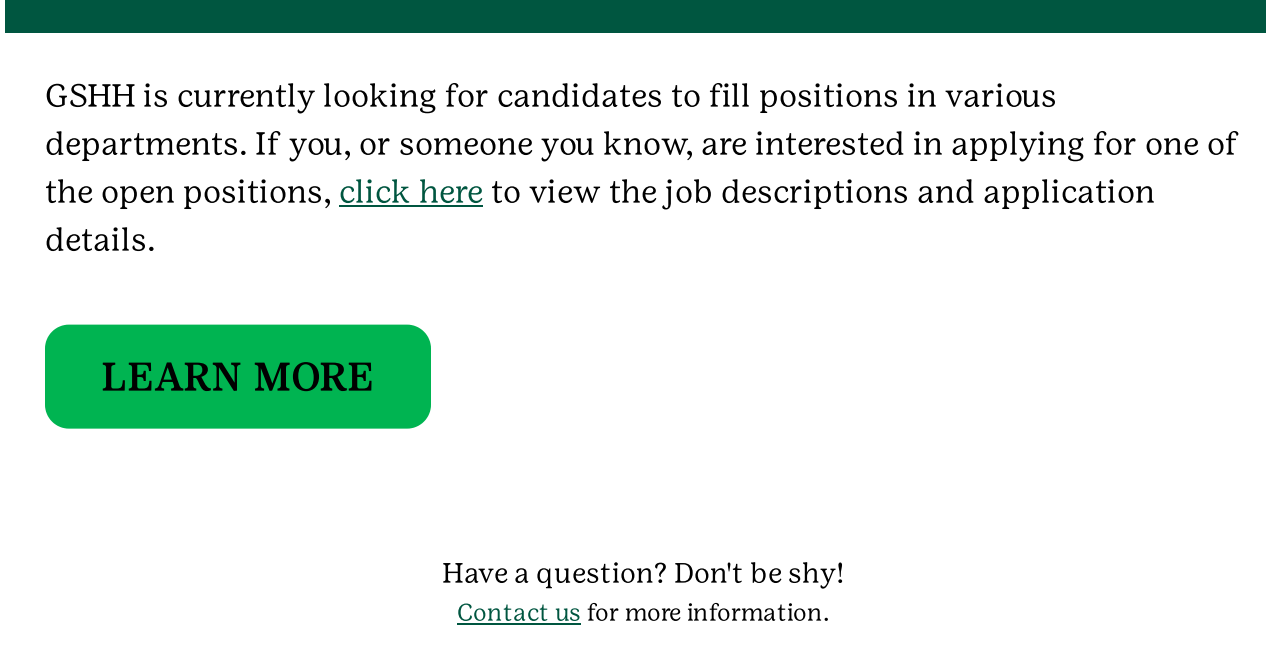
