Daypack

Suggested Equipment List: Overnight CAMPING

*You will be carrying your camping equipment from the parking area to the camping area.

*Dinner and breakfast will be provided; no cooking, personal campsite fires or camp stoves are allowed in the fairgrounds

Bring your own tent/sleeping accommodations (watch the weather: extra traps to keep everything dry if rain is predicted)

Your wagon to carry equipment to camping area

Troop First Aid kit

Sleeping bag

Sleeping pad/mattress and small pillow

Sleepwear and toiletries

Extra pair of socks and underwear

Flashlight with extra batteries

You may bring extra snack foods and drinks (coolers allowed).
