## GIRL BOARD DIRECTOR APPLICATION Term 2021 – 2022

### Requirements:

- You must be a registered Girl Scout for the 2020-2021 Membership year
- You must be at least 16 years of age by April 22, 2021

### Be able to:

- Serve a one year term
- Attend and complete Board Director Orientation and training
- Accept the principles, beliefs, and purpose of Girl Scouting
- Demonstrative effective communication skills
- Represent the girl voice at meetings and events
- Possess mature judgment, flexibility and enthusiasm, and the ability to follow through with commitments
- Be available to attend Board and committee meetings, generally on a monthly basis
- Be available to attend the Annual Meeting on April 22, 2021

### Application:

Submit the following by **11:59 PM - Wednesday, December 30, 2020**:

- [The application](#) – Only complete applications will be considered
- Two letters of recommendation; one from a Girl Scout adult member and one from a non-Girl Scout member not related to you
- A personal essay that must be 500 words or less and include the following information:
- Number of years in Girl Scouting
- Your Girl Scout experience (Higher Awards earned, CIT, etc.)
- Extracurricular activities
- Your plans after high school (undecided, college, local career, military, etc.)
- Why you are interested in becoming a Girl Scouts Heart of the Hudson, Inc. Girl Director

The Board Development Committee asks any interested girls to review this application with their parents or guardian and receive their permission prior to submitting an application.
