# **COVID-19 Questions**

- When will GSHH update its COVID-19 guidelines?
  - o GSHH's <u>COVID-19 Guidelines</u> were updated on March 1<sup>st</sup>. This update removed the indoor mask mandate and COVID-19 pre-screening questionnaire.
- Are GSHH's COVID-19 guidelines required or recommended?
  - The GSHH COVID-19 guidelines document includes both required and recommended guidelines to best guide you.
- Where do the GSHH COVID-19 guidelines come from?
  - GSHH management monitors the most current updates from the CDC, NYS, and local DOH departments and reviews the existing guidelines to ensure that you have up to date information.
- How do we push to have them more updated to the present CDC and school rules, etc.?
  - GSHH is not affiliated with educational settings. We continue to monitor the available mandates by NYS, CDC, and will update as necessary for Girl Scouts.
