- Can SUMs be included in the First Year Leader Meet-Up follow-up email to share information with any volunteers who were not able to attend?
  - Yes, after both meet-ups, an email will be sent out to all first-year volunteers.
     SUMs can be included in that email.
- Trip Activity Notification Packet
  - Can more details on insurance options be shared and explained (for example, what does the Basic Plan mean and include)?
    - Plan 1 Is for members with a current membership and lasting up to two consecutive nights or less. This coverage is included in the \$25 membership registration.
    - Plan 2 Is for members with a current membership and non-members at events or for more than two consecutive nights. There is a charge per person per day.
    - We will provide a chart with additional information on Activity Accident Insurance at the next SU Manager Meet Up.
  - o When is non-member/additional insurance required?
    - Additional insurance is required anytime a non-member attends a Girl Scout event.
    - Additional insurance is required for current members if a trip lasts 3 or more nights.
- Money Earning Applications
  - How do we verify that a troop has participated in both product sales before approving an MEA?

- Checking that a troop has participated in product sales is part of the Service Unit Manager's box on the MEA. If you are not sure whether or not 50% of a troop has participated, you can ask the troop leader or email Customer Care at <a href="mailto:customercare@girlscoutshh.org">customercare@girlscoutshh.org</a>. Please use the subject line: Troop Product Sales Participation
- o If a girl is doing a MEA for a higher award, but her family has not participated in Annual Giving, is that going to prevent her from getting approval?
  - No, a girl will not be penalized because her family did not participate in Annual Giving the prior year
- Is there a lag in Looker?
  - Looker updates once daily, it isn't a live update like the roster in your MYGS account
- Do you have a "Job description" for the new recruiter?
  - o This is the Volunteer Position Description for a Service Unit Recruiter
- If a troop is going to be donating profits from an event to an event that isn't expected to
  make money to Annual Giving, do they need to complete a final report? For example, an
  SU is hosting an event that isn't a money earning event but they happen to make
  money from it with number of people attending and/or donations. They then plan to
  give any kind of potential profit to Annual Giving.
  - No, they do not need to complete an MEA or final report in this situation. It should be done the way any other annual giving donation would be done. If a donor requires a receipt, it would need to be done directly through Fund Development.
