



Dear Girl Scouts Heart of the Hudson Community,

We are excited to update you with the information that sale of the Pleasantville office building is approved and we are currently scheduled to close and be out of the building by Friday, December 9th. In light of this, the Pleasantville retail shop will be closed as of Monday, November 28th. The last to shop in person will be Saturday, November 26th.

We will continue to have a physical retail presence in Westchester County. We are looking to early to mid-December to open our temporary pilot retail space in the New Rochelle Girl Center. We will update you when we have a better idea on the opening date and schedule for that location. We anticipate to be in this location through summer 2023 when the property advisory committee completes its assessment of council properties. In the interim, the retail shops at Montgomery, New City, and Wappingers Falls will be open on their regular schedules. Please [check here](#) for up-to-date schedules.

Be on the lookout in early 2023 for news about our mobile retail van pilot program that will provide increased accessibility to troops and service units. If you have any questions about retail, please contact [Member Care](#). You can also check [our website](#) for updates.

GSHH is currently looking at possibilities for cookie booths in Westchester and will announce that information when confirmed.

Council staff is currently in the process of moving out of the building. Packing up a building of this size with decades of history takes a lot of time, logistics, teamwork, and coordination, and we appreciate your patience as we work to vacate the Pleasantville office and move to Montgomery and other council-owned locations. Thank you also to the Techno Teams for being so flexible and working with GSHH to coordinate their move to the Port Chester Girl Center.

Going forward, the official address and the administrative office of the council will be 30 Scotts Corner Drive Montgomery, NY 12549.

Some FAQs:

Q. How do we contact the retail shop?

A. The phone number for the New Rochelle location will remain the same, 914-747-3080 ext.730.

Q. How will this affect members and volunteers in Westchester?

A. Some staff will be working out of Girl Centers in Westchester and will be available to assist members and volunteers in the area. More information will be announced as it is confirmed and as schedules are set.

Q. Will there be a closing ceremony for the building?

A. With the closure of the shop on 11/26, that will be the last time the building will be open to the public. If you want to pay a final visit to the building, you may pay a visit to the shop on or before 11/26.

This is a big change for everyone at Girl Scouts Heart of the Hudson, but we believe it to be a positive one. We look forward to your continued cooperation as we complete this move and settle into our new spaces.
