Make an Anaconda or Red-eyed Tree Frog!

For the anaconda you will need:

- Paper plate
- Green marker or paint
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Red construction paper



Steps:

- 1) Color or paint your paper plate green.
- 2) Cut a small strip of red construction paper and cut out a triangle in that strip so you're left with a tongue.
- 3) Cut your plate into a spiral shape, leaving a bigger spot at the top for the head.
- 4) Glue on the tongue and the googly eyes and now you have an anaconda!

For the red-eyed tree frog you will need

- Paper plate
- Green and red marker or paint
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Green construction paper
- Glue



Steps:

- 1) Color or paint your paper plate green.
- 2) Cut out 4 thin legs with feet at the end using the green construction paper.
- 3) Draw red feet and toes and color them in.
- 4) Draw red eyes on your paper plate.
- 5) Glue the legs to the bottom of the paper plate and now you have a red-eyed tree frog!
