GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

To enrich the campers experience at camp by providing activities that encourage the preservation, appreciation, and understanding of our lake's ecosystem while maintaining a safe program as directed by Girl Scouts of the USA, the American Camp Association and the New York State Department of Health.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES

- Develop a variety of nature and fishing activities in accordance to objectives and standards set by the camp.
- The Fishing Specialist should consider the interest and abilities of campers in relation to progression of activities.
- Work with the Program Manager in coordinating fishing activities in relation to the camp's session themes and activities.
- Requisition necessary equipment and supplies before and during camp; cares for equipment; requests necessary repairs.
- Keep records and reports as necessary.
- Maintain highest level of safety during activities.
- Report any illness or injury to the Nurse/EMT and Camp Director promptly.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Experience in working with children.
- Experience in organizing and leading a variety of nature and environmental activities.
