GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

PRINCIPLE DUTIES

- Carry out assigned waterfront activities.
- Participate in special waterfront events.
- Assist Boating Manager as required.
- Assist with the coordination of waterfront search drills for weekly staff in-service training.
- Enforce water safety measures at the waterfront.
- Help to take care of waterfront equipment, facilities, and supplies; reports repairs needed to Aquatics Manager.
- Keep records and makes reports as required.
- Participate in general camp activities.
