### Pajama Party Basics

Who doesn't love staying up late, doing silly things, telling stories, and eating junk food? Let's start with your Pajama Party basics...

Who?

Who will be invited to the event—older girls, younger girls, mixed age groups? Be sure to send out invites and post on social media for the best outcome!

When?

Be sure to pick a time and day that works best for everyone. Keep in mind this event should be adjusted to work for your troop. Will this be a day event with drop off and pick up? Or will this event be a true sleepover that requires additional overnight planning?

Where?

Where will you host the event: your meeting place, your local church, an aquarium? They are so many options. Just remember to submit a TANP should the event take place away from your troop meeting place.

What?

What supplies will you need and what activities will take place? Be sure to check out our tips and activities provided in this guide!

How?

How will you keep this girl-led? Will you ask girls what activities they are interested in beforehand? Will you ask girls to come in rainbow pajamas? Will adults be invited? Will you customize this event to the time of year? The possibilities are endless!

### Pajama Party Themes

Color Wars:

Ask each troop level to wear a different-colored pajama set to represent their Girl Scouting journey. You could also ask each troop to bring snacks based on their assigned color.

Movie Night:

Hosting a movie night with lots of movie theater snacks is a classic activity at pajama parties. Don't forget the popcorn!

Holiday Party:

No matter the time of year, you could use a holiday as your theme, like Halloween for October or matching Christmas family pajamas in December!

Glow in the Dark:

Decorate with neon colors and pass out glow sticks to all the guests as they arrive for an epic pajama party theme!



### Pajama Party Games

#### Show and Tell

Ask each girl to bring a pillow blanket and their favorite stuffed animal. Have the girls sit in a circle and each share what stuffed animal they brought and why it's their favorite.

#### Freeze Dance

In this game, everyone dances as the music plays. When the music stops, each player must freeze immediately and hold that position until the music begins again.

#### Make it a Game Night

Everyone loves a good board game. Friends and family can gather rain or shine to play a favorite classic or try out something new. Board games can make you laugh and make you think, and they always lead to a great time. This is another fun and simple activity we recommend. Ask each troop to bring a board game to this event and have a blast!

#### Girl Scout Karaoke

Fire up the karaoke machine and let loose. Print up lyric sheets for everything from Girl Scout songs to Top 40 hits to get things started.

- Crayons


- Rhinestones

- Glitter


- Scissors

#### **DIY Eye Mask Instructions:**

- 1. Print and cut out the eye mask template
- 2. Trace template on choice of material: fabric, felt, construction paper
- 3. Cut out two holes at the end of the mask for string of choice: string, elastic, yarn
- 4. Design and customize your eye mask: rhinestones, glitter, stickers
- 5. Attach string of choice to mask
- 6. Rock your eye mask with GSHH pride!
