About





What is eBudde?

eBudde is the online cookie sale management system used by Little Brownie Bakers (one of the Girl Scout cookie suppliers) to help Girl Scout leaders organize sales during the annual cookie program.

It is a user-friendly platform accessible via desktop and a mobile app, integrating with Digital Cookie® to provide a comprehensive tool for cookie season management.



Many volunteers use the desktop version to get the hang of the system and enter initial information, then use the app for the remainder of the season.

How do I access eBudde?

To gain access to eBudde, all Service Unit and Troop Cookie Chairs must contact Member Care (call 855-232-4744 or email membercare@girlscoutshh.org) and complete the following requirements:

- 1. Be a currently registered and background checked volunteer with GSHH**
- 2. Submit a Product Program Agreement (available on the GSHH website).**
- 3. Complete their assigned training in gsLearn at <https://mygs.girlscouts.org/>.**



Now What?

Once volunteers are granted access to eBudde, they should look for an email from eBudde/Little Brownie Bakers with instructions on how to set up login credentials. Some volunteers may be able to use the same login credential if returning for the new season.

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To navigate the eBudde App effectively, follow these steps:

Log in: Use the email address and password provided in the introductory email to set up your account. Ensure the 2025-2026 season is active.





Dashboard: Once logged in, you will see the default view on the Dashboard, where you can manage your troop and view all troops associated with you.

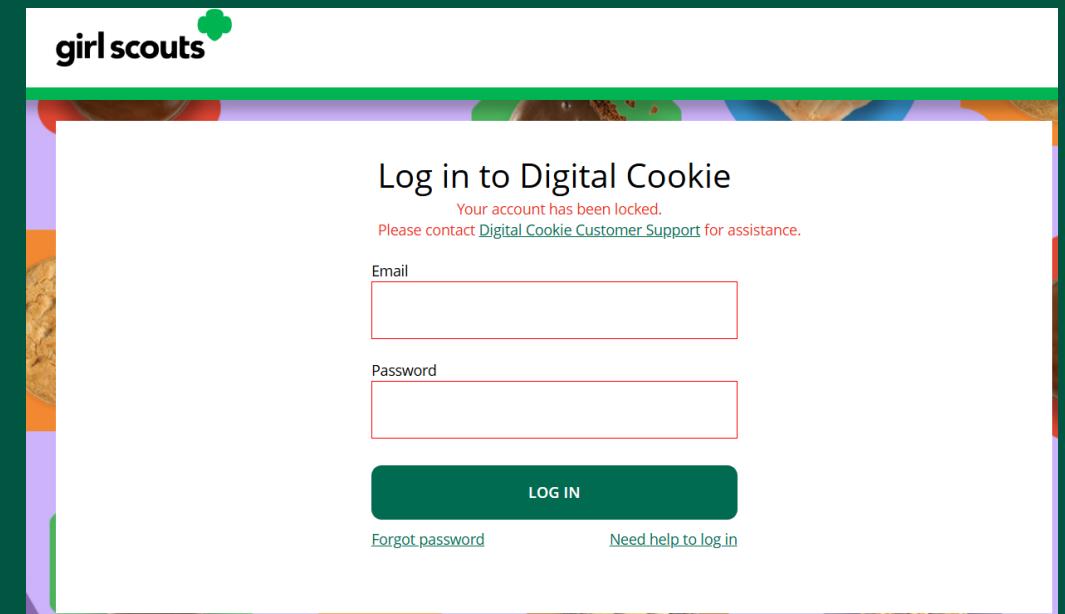

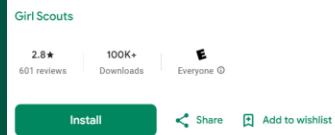

Digital Cookie in a Nutshell

- Caregivers are responsible for managing the orders that come in through their Girl Scout's Digital Cookie site.
- Selling cookies online without the exchange of an order card and cash payment is a safe and easy way to ensure customers can get the cookies they love from the comfort of their home. Digital Cookie offers a mobile app for caregivers to help girls collect orders in-person, and at cookie booths.
- Registered Girl Scouts will be sent an email invitation at the start of the Cookie Program with a unique link to set up their account, as well as instructions for downloading the mobile app and adding their email contacts.

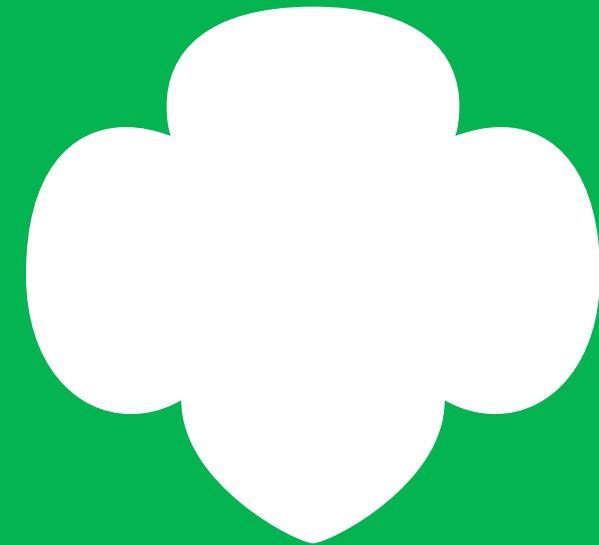
All users login to their Digital Cookie account using the URL: <https://digitalcookie.girlscouts.org/login> All users will gain access as long as they have completed the following requirements:

2. Completed the Product Program Agreement

Initial Order



(Phase 1)

Initial Order refers to the first phase of Girl Scout Cookie orders placed by a Troop at the beginning of the Cookie Season.

The Initial Order phase helps the troop estimate the total number of cookies needed for the season, including those for planned booth sales and individual orders.

Girl Scouts collect orders from customers using traditional order cards or through Digital Cookie.

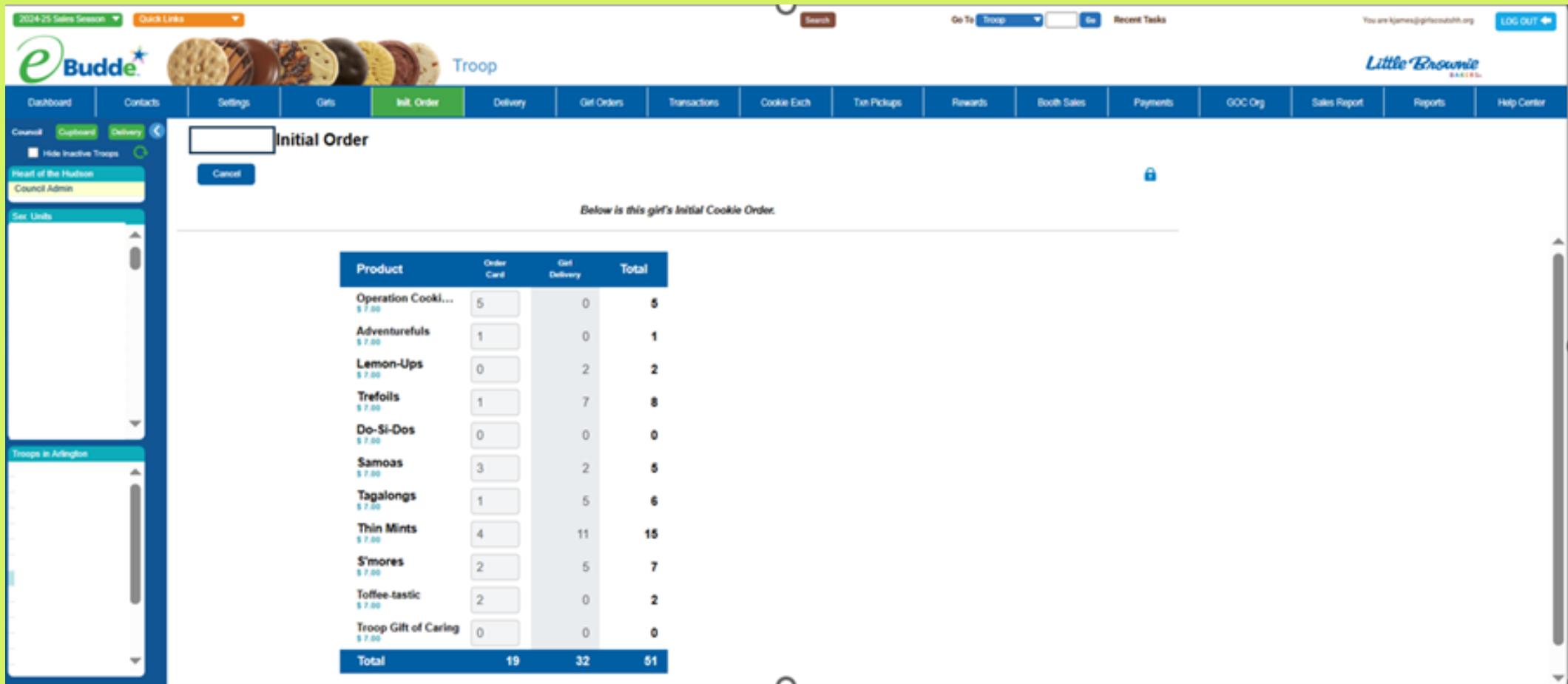

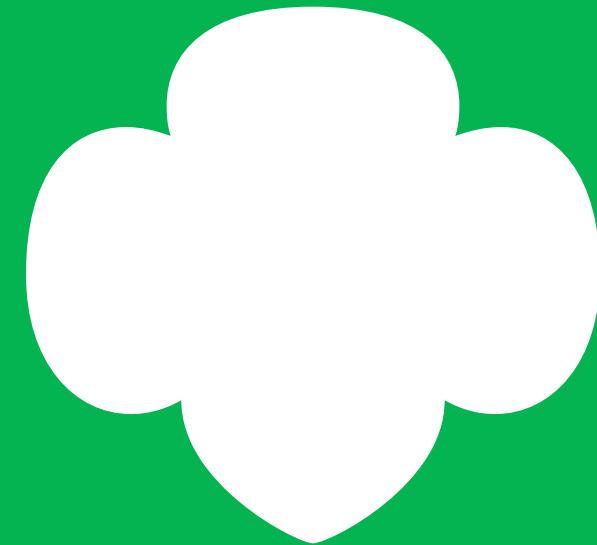
*SUVs/Wagons need to have rear seats folded down to reach the case capacity. Wagons or smaller SUVs like Honda CRVs, Toyota Rav4s, and Ford Escapes may hold closer to 50-75 case capacity.

**A standard pickup truck without straps, a tarp, or cap, will hold only around 35-50 cases in the bed.

What if you Miss Your Cookie Delivery?

- If your Troop misses your scheduled pickup, please contact Member Care (membercare@girlscoutshh.org) or your Council Product Sales Specialist right away.
- Please note that delivery trucks are loaded daily and only with the delivery information scheduled for that day. If you miss your scheduled date/time, your order will be returned to the warehouse for further pickup instructions. You may have to pick up your order there.

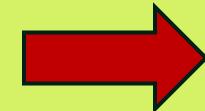

Troop Profit

Troops earn \$1.00 per package.

If troops attained a PGA of 110 or above during I/O and sold \$1,200 or more during the 2025 Fall Product Sale, they will earn an additional 10¢ per package during initial order.

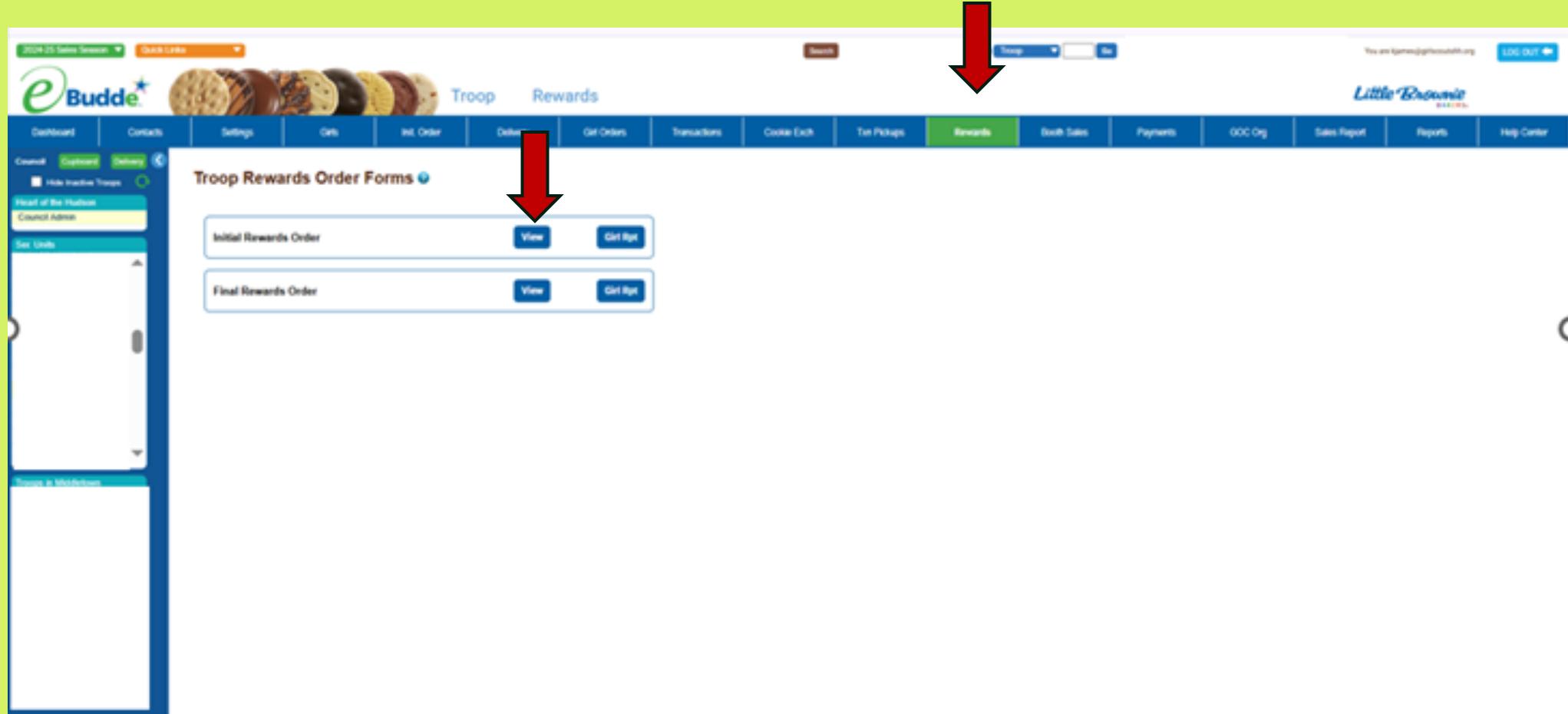
At the end of the sale, if a troop has a PGA of 150 or more, they will earn an additional 10¢ per package.

Junior/Cadette/Senior/Ambassador troops and J/C/S/A Juliettes, who attain a PGA of 110 packages sold during initial order who choose to opt out of physical cookie rewards will receive an additional \$0.10 per package sold during this cookie season.

The maximum proceeds a troop can earn is \$1.30.

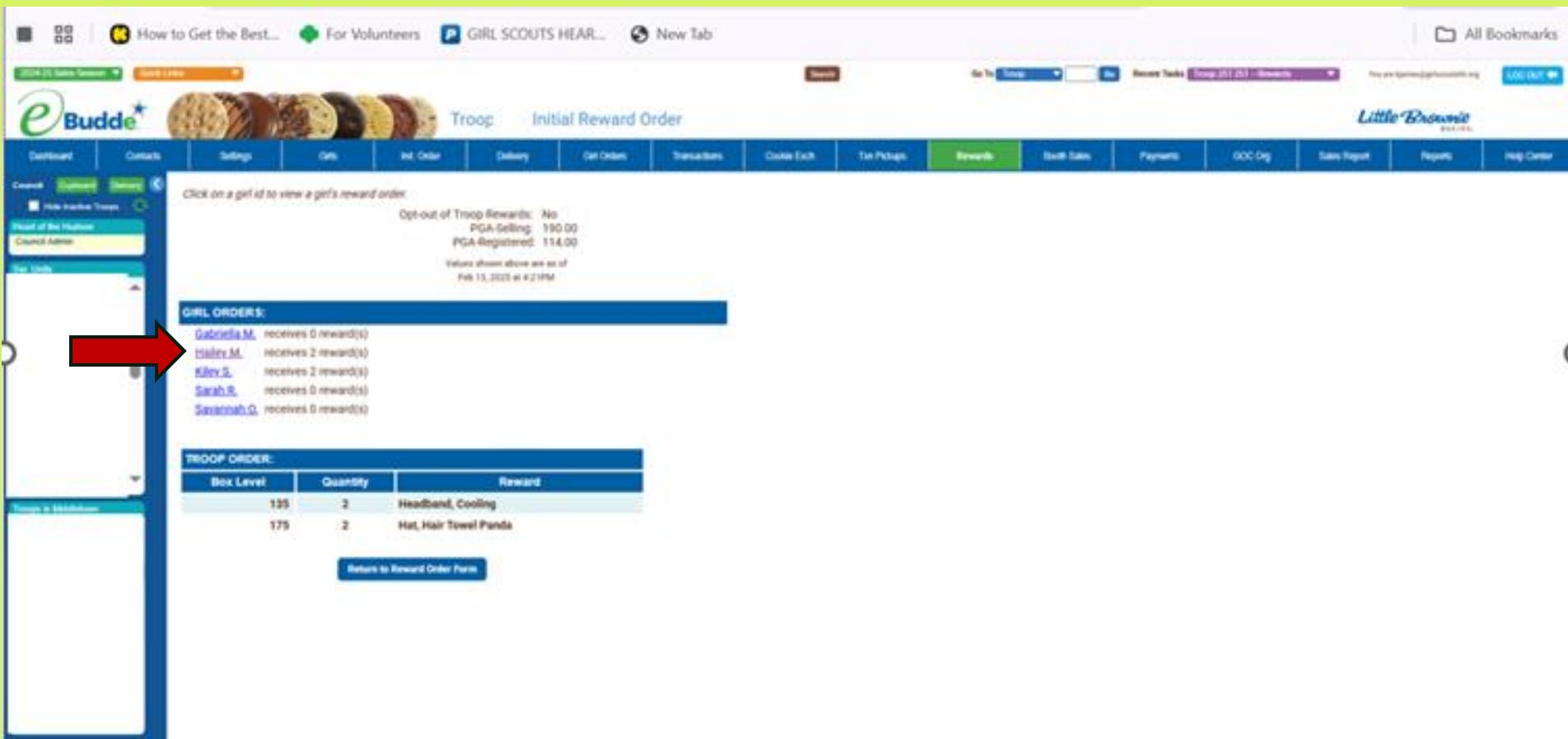

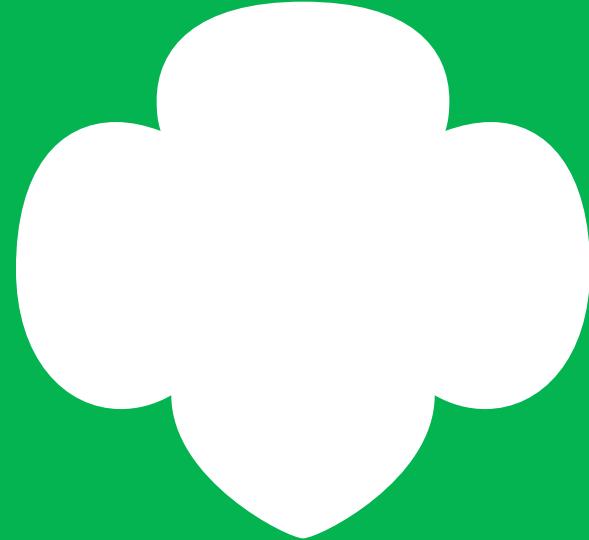
